Formed at Trinity Laban Conservatoire, Aurum Nactum has a passion for traditional folksong which it interprets through the prism of contemporary composition and improvisation. It is named after the 'stumbled-across gold' that they discover in their attempts to find different angles from which to explore their music. Familiarity with improvisation allows a freedom that is true to the spirit of the songs, whilst an awareness of more contemporary harmony adds a further dimension. 'Anything goes' in development - Britten, Vaughan Williams, Purcell, John Coltrane - but Aurum Nactum's mantra is to keep the original meaning of each song as the foundation of its performance.

Anbjørg Bergheim is a Norwegian jazz singer. As a member of the London Vocal Project she has worked with numerous established jazz musicians some of the notable being Bobby McFerrin, Cleo Lane and John Dankworth, and a master class with Jon Hendricks.





Tom Millar, who is a graduate of both Cambridge and the RAM, is a jazz pianist and composer. He is already active on the London scene, playing at venues such as the Wigmore Hall, King's Place, 606

Club and Jazz Cafe; and his music has been performed in many major venues by groups such as the NYO and Endymion.

Diccon Cooper has a background in jazz double bass, but has also played harpsichord. His ensembles include the Amalgamation Project, a group of Greek folk musicians based in London, and Jazz Knights big band.
