

Many people have a connection with St Lawrence Jewry. People have been married here or joined in celebrating the marriages of family or riends. Others have come here because of links with their family history. People have joined in civic events here through involvement with the City of London Corporation or a Livery Company or some other connection. Some have come, regularly or when they can, to our weekday services and lunchtime concerts. Many treasure the quiet ranguillity of this sacred and beautiful place, with its unique history stretching back over 850 years, in the heart of a busy City.

People often say to me —"I love this church".

The Friends of St Lawrence Jewry is a way in which you can strengthen hose links and can provide active and much needed support for the thurch and its very special ministry to the City of London. As the official hurch of the City of London Corporation we have long received upport from the City. However, modern realities mean we can no onger rely solely on that support to maintain the building and fund its ninistry.

There has been a church on this site since at least 1180, and preserving it ind carrying on its work has presented successive generations with their own special challenges. After the building was completely destroyed in he Great Fire of London in 1666 it was built anew by Sir Christopher Wren. It was completely restored following very severe damage in the econdWorldWar, and that was completed in 1957. The Klais organ was nstalled in 2000, maintaining the church's fine musical tradition. Today's hallenge is that, 50 years on from the post-war restoration, the building s now in urgent need of significant repair, and meeting the cost demands iew ways of funding. One reason for setting up the Friends is to help chieve this.




