A Service of Remembrance for the Parachute Regiment and Airborne Forces will take place on Friday 8th November at 11:30am.

Thanksgiving No. 6 - Christmas Appeal – Bibles for Rwanda

The church learned, through Adewale Ayodeji Ajayi, one of our regular worshippers in the church, that Rwanda, one of the smallest countries on the African mainland, has Christianity as the largest religion. The people there are apparently desperate for bibles. Ade approached us to see if the church can help in providing bibles to them. Through his connection, he managed to find a printer that can print the bible at only £7 per unit.

So, our Christmas Appeal this year is to provide at least 500 bibles to Rwanda. Any donation towards this cause will be highly appreciated but we invite you to donate £35 for a pack of 5 bibles. Not only will the people of Rwanda be thankful for your generosity, the church will also include you and your loved ones in our prayers during the weekly services in December. You can give your donation to the church office by card, cash or cheque (payable to "St Lawrence Jewry"). Let us help spread God's Word in Rwanda by providing them the bibles that they desperately need.

Thanksgiving No. 7 - Crowding Fund

We also recently launched a Crowdfunding Appeal through Space Hive for the restoration of our Steinway grand piano. It was made in 1926 and was originally owned by including Sir Thomas Beecham. It is regularly used during our weekly piano lunchtime recitals and other events. Although we do our best to keep it in good-working condition, it now needs a major restoration to put it back to the international playing standard. We need £8,625 to make this happen.
